LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

The main language of instruction is Italian, all courses are taught in Italian.

Each Bachelor and Master has both practical courses and theoretical courses. Given the practical nature of the art courses, there is no formal requirements for Italian proficiency for incoming students. Applicants are strongly encouraged to have a sufficient proficiency in English to communicate with students and teachers. Students who want to attend theoretical classes (i.e. History of Art, Anthropology, Aesthetics) are strongly advised to have at least a B1 in Italian.

ITALIAN LANGUAGE COURSE

Two weeks before the beginning of the semester Erasmus+ Incoming students are expected to arrive to ABAMC for the Welcome Day and to attend the intensive Italian language course.

The course is offered by ABAMC to all Erasmus+ Incoming students and is held at the Language School Italiano&Co. Attending the course will provide 2 ECTS on the Transcript of Records.

COURSE STRUCTURE AND OLA

Erasmus+ ABAMC manages all learning agreements through EWP students can create their Online Learning Agreement on the OLA website.

Each Bachelor and Master have one main course lasting two semesters for 12 ECTS.

Incoming students for one semester can attend the annual courses and get half the credits at the end of the semester (6 ECTS)

ACCOMODATION

Academy of Fine Arts Macerata does not provide students with accommodation nor it has reserved dorm rooms for students.

Students can apply for a dorm through the University platform but acceptance is not guaranteed.

Upon acceptance the Erasmus+ Office will provide the students with a list of landlords that usually accept Exchange Students for semester rentals.

CAMPUS

Classes are held in five different buildings located in the city center or nearby. They are all easily accessible by foot or bus.

VISA

Incoming students from non-UE countries have to register to University platform in order to apply for the study VISA.

Incoming students from non-UE countries are supposed to apply for a resident permit (Permesso di Soggiorno) upon their arrival in Italy even if they have a valid VISA.

The Erasmus Office is available to help students fill their resident permit application.
